Geegeez Laying System

What is Geegeez Laying System? And what are the systems?

A Laying system is where you are backing an event to lose, for example betting on a horse to lose. There are a 3 separate horse laying systems with Geegeez Laying System (GLS):

- System A: Flat racing, on course odds range 2/1 – 14/1
- System B: AW (All Weather) racing, which only operates from November to March, on course odds range 7/2 or shorter
- System C: Jump racing, no odds range

How are the horses chosen?

The horses are selected according to a strict ruleset, for each of Systems A, B and C. In each case, the results have been proven over a period of more than five years.

Because of the nature of the rules, it is entirely possible for more than one horse to be laid in a race.

What odds do you lay at?

There are three sub-systems to the laying service, and they have odds thresholds as identified of 14/1 (A), 7/2 (B) and any price (C) respectively. In reality, there are rarely horses at very big prices.

Since we've been in live operation (from 5th November 2008), there was a single 25/1 shot (pulled up), but otherwise nothing bigger than 14's. Average odds have been around 11/2.

Laying on Betfair typically involves offering odds greater than the traditional bookmakers offer. So a 'cushion' of 20% above SP is factored in to allow for this. Also, when you successfully lay a horse, the betting exchange will deduct a commission of up to 5% (it can be less than this depending on how much you bet, but never more) from your winnings. How big a bank do you recommend?

Laying System involves taking on some horses at odds of 12/1 or 14/1. And, occasionally, these horses win. As such, ***a bank is essential*** for users of Laying System.

I recommend *at least* 75 points and ideally 100 points. A point is a unit of stake. So, for instance, if you had £1,000 for your bank, then a 100 point bank would make each point worth £10.

What about losing runs?

Losing runs are part of any systematic approach to horse racing betting. It is an incontrovertible truth that if a system has a strike rate of less than 100% it will have losers. (And I've yet to find the 100% strike rate system!)

So yes, Laying System does have losing runs, and occasionally they are painful. Our worst losing day cost us around 30 points. These were recouped within a fortnight.

Laying System can be volatile and, as such, it's not for everyone. This is why I urge caution and paper trading during the free trial period.

When are the lays available?

The horses are almost always available from/ before 6.00am English time. If you are using the bot software, as long as the bot is running, it will pick the selections up as and when they become available.

I'm worried that the odds are too high. Can you reassure me?

The odds in absolute terms may seem high. However, relative to the performance of the horses they are not.

What I mean by this is that if a horse that fits a certain pattern has been shown to win on average once in 25 runs, would you be happy to lay it at 12/1? I would, and Laying System does. In reality, we have to lay these horses at closer to 20/1 but that still leaves us with 20% profit over time.

[As I hope you understand, Laying System is a serious tool that grows a bank impressively over time. It is NOT a golden goose that lays (pardon the pun) a daily golden egg.]

What does it cost to subscribe?

You can subscribe **for a full 21 days, at no cost to you**. If you like and get on with the system, then you may continue your subscription at £59 a month. There are deep discounts for those committed enough to sign up for a longer period:

- Laying System (Annual Subscription)** (Free for the first 21 days. Then £499.00 for each year)
- Laying System (Quarterly)** (Free for the first 21 days. Then £149.00 for each 3 months)
- Laying System (Monthly)** (Free for the first 21 days. Then £59.00 for each month)

How do I cancel?

Of course, we don't want you to cancel, but we understand that the Laying System approach will not be to everybody's tastes or appetite for risk. So we've made it as easy as possible to cancel.

Please be aware that the second file is very big and, as such, it will take some time to download. I don't recommend downloading it on a dial-up connection (!)

As I write (mid-July), we are nearly 120 points in profit since November last year, at an average monthly profit of around 15 points.

Compare this with the best lay tipster profit on Racing Index's proofing site of around 23 points since January 2009:

Allied to the fact that Laying System is a fully automated solution, and you can see why we're so proud of the service.

Can I just lay one or two of the systems? (e.g. the ones with the shortest odds)

You can lay any horse or horses you like from the selections. However, be aware that if you 'pick and choose' your lays, I cannot vouch for the profitability of that subset of the runners.

Obviously, all runners are chosen on the de-merits, but that is not to say that you will lay winners and avoid losers!

In short, my recommendation is to lay all runners identified and qualifying by the system. Any deviation from this will generate a different set of results for users.

How do I use the bot software?

I'm very proud of the bot software, which has been designed to be the most user-friendly and simple software on the market. It is completely tailored to be used with Laying System and, once you've initially configured it (about five minutes max), you just click the 'bet now' button each time you load it on your computer.

From there, choose the 'Download GLS Laying Software' link and follow the prompts.

Once you have downloaded the bot, you fill in the boxes with the relevant information (as per the above instructions), and then click the flashing 'bet button'.

Do you have a summary of what all the buttons do?

Yes. Once successfully logged in, you may make some changes to your settings, as follows:

Firstly, your stake controls, then results tracker and the period of time prior to the advertised race time that you wish to strike the bet: "Time to bet".

Below this, the selections panel displays any uploaded selections.

As any qualifying bets are struck, the details will appear alongside the selection showing the price "odds" and the stake matched "size" when the race goes in play the GLS bot will track the race winner and this information will be displayed in the selection column, the bet outcome "PnL" of the bet will show in the result column.

There is of course MUCH more information in the instructions in the previous section.

How do I remove a horse from the software?

To remove a horse from the software you simply click the 'x' to the left of the selection once to 'gray it out' and tell the software you do not wish to lay it.

NOTE: Beware if you click the 'x' twice, the horse will be deleted from your screen but will re-appear the next time the software makes a call to the 'selections' server. That is, if you click the 'x' twice, the horse will re-appear in your software and you will be matched on that horse..
